LAST GAME: The Cyclones defeated the Jamestown Jammers by the score of 5-2 on Wednesday evening...**Javier Rodriguez** connected on a two-RBI triple in the second inning to give Brooklyn an early 4-0 lead...**Marco Camarena** struck out eight over his 4.2 innings but did not factor in the decision...**Orlando Tovar** collected his fifth win of the season after tossing 1.1 scoreless innings of relief.

CYCLONES VS. JAMMERS: The Cyclones are 19-13 all-time against Jamestown...In 2001, the Cyclones played the first game in franchise history against the Jamestown Jammers at Diethrick Park on June 19th...It was a 2-1 win.

AT THE GAME TODAY: Tonight is New York Football Night and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will have the choice of a Green or Blue Cyclones Football Jersey as we hold a Jersey-Lecture to see which color rules the gridiron in NYC...Former Jet Marty Lyons and former Giant George Martin will be on hand to sign autographs as the Cyclones raise funds for the Marty Lyons Foundation and the NFL Alumni Assoc.

NEXT HOME GAME: Friday night means fireworks on Coney Island...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive Cyclones Earbuds courtesy of GEICO...It will also be Girl Scout Night at the ballpark.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones pitching staff ranks first in the NYPL in ERA at 3.08...They have allowed a league low 155 walks while ranking third in the league with 453 strikeouts...The 23 home runs allowed are tied for the second fewest in the league and the 207 runs allowed are a league low.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a .971 fielding percentage...They have committed a league low 61 errors in 57 games.

CHARLEY DOWN: Cyclones outfielder **Charley Thurber** is 2-24 over his last six games...During the month of August he is batting just .189 (10-53) and has seen his batting average drop from .303 to .263.

MUNO ON THE MONEY: Cyclones short-stop **Danny Munro** has scored a run in each of his last six games...Since returning from the Disabled List on July 7th, he is hitting .345 (50-145)...Since July 15th, when Munro scores a run the Cyclones are 13-2...For the season Brooklyn is 17-6 when Munro scores a run.

HOT ROD: Brooklyn outfielder **Javier Rodriguez** is hitting .355 (11-31) over his last eight games with four multi-hit contests and 11 RBI over the span...Prior to his recent hot streak, J-Rod was 3-33 over his previous 11 contests.

START ME UP: The Cyclones are 5-1 in their last six games. Over the span, Brooklyn starters have collected three wins after having only one between July 16th and August 8th...Over the last six games, Cyclones starters have pitched to a 1.82 ERA (six earned runs / 29.2 innings).

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 68 runners and allowing only 14 of them to score (20.59%)...By comparison, the Philadelphia Phillies bullpen leads MLB with a 22.2 % (20-90).

TONIGHT'S STARTER : RHP # 34 Eduardo Aldama (3-3, 4.06 ERA)

- His 58 strikeouts are tied for second in the NYPL.
- Combined with fellow starter Marco Camarena to post back-to-back wins on 8/10 and 8/11. It was the first time Cyclones starters posted back-to-back wins since Aldama and Carlos Vazquez did so on 7/14 and 7/15.
- His K/9 ratio of 10.24 leads Brooklyn's starting rotation.
- Allowed home runs in three consecutive starts this season (7/24, 7/30, 8/4). Had not allowed homers in consecutive starts since 8/5/10 and 8/11/10 while at Kingsport (R).
- Has an ERA of 10.64 in the third inning (23 ER/11.0 IP). In contrast, he has posted a 1.64 ERA in the second inning (2 ER/11.0 IP) and a 4.91 ERA in the first inning (6 ER/11.0 IP).
- Is pitching to a 2.66 ERA at home (6 ER/20.1 IP) and 4.99 ERA on the road (17 ER/30.2 IP)
- Has held righthanded hitters to a .233 average and .336 slugging percentage. Lefthanders, however, are hitting .263 and slugging .474 off of him.
