LAST GAME: The Cyclones and ValleyCats had their game suspended by rain with Tri-City leading 6-2 in the top of the fourth inning...**Chris Hilliard** made the start and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in his first outing in six weeks...**Randy Fontanez** allowed six runs, three earned, in his 1.1 innings before the game was suspended.

CYCLONES VS. VALLEY CATS: The Cyclones are 27-13 against the Tri-City ValleyCats all-time during the regular season...Tri-City is 1-4 against the Cyclones in the post-season.

AT THE GAME TODAY: Brooklyn closes out their six game home stand on Monday...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones team photo...The team will also honor American Idol's Pia Toscano in a pre-game ceremony...Following the game it will be Meet the Cyclones Monday with autograph sessions on the field.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones return to MCU Park on Friday, August 26th...There will be post-game fireworks and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a FREE Metrocard presented by Verizon Wireless.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones pitching staff ranks second in the NYPL in ERA at 3.04...They have allowed a league low 166 walks while ranking third in the league with 469 strikeouts...The 23 home runs allowed are tied for the second fewest in the league and the 212 runs allowed are also a league-low.

PLAYOFF PUSH: The Cyclones come into tonight's games 3.0 games behind SI and 1.0 game behind Williamsport for the wild card.

COLE RAKING: First baseman **Cole Frenzel** is hitting .345 (10-29) over his last nine games to raise his average from a season-low .207 to .244...The former Arizona Wildcat has an RBI in four of his last five games after driving in one run in his previous 13.

CHARLEY DOWN: Cyclones outfielder **Charley Thurber** is 3-31 (.097) over his last eight games...During the month of August he is batting just .183 (11-60) and has seen his batting average drop from .303 to .258.

MUNO ON THE MONEY: Since returning from the Disabled List on July 7th, he is hitting .333 (51-153)...Since July 15th, when Muno scores a run the Cyclones are 13-2...For the season Brooklyn is 17-6 when Muno scores a run...The All-Star short stop has scored at least one run in six of his last eight games

T.J. IS OK: Cyclones infielder **T.J. Rivera** is hitting .381 (8-21) since joining the Cyclones on August 6th...He has hit safely in five of his six games with an at-bat.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: This season, when the Cyclones score five or more runs the team is 23-5...Conversely, when they score four runs or less the team is 11-20.

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 72 runners and allowing only 15 of them to score (20.8%)...By comparison, the Philadelphia Phillies bullpen leads MLB with a 22.2% (20-90).

- Has allowed only two runs over his last 23.0 dating to the fifth inning on July 23rd.
- Struck out a season-high
- Allowed four home runs over two starts from July 18th-23rd, including three against Lowell on 7/18...Had not allowed a home run since August 17, 2009 with the DSL Mets against the DSL Giants prior to that start.
- Tossed 6.0 innings on June 26th vs. Aberdeen to collect his first win of the season. The 6.0 innings is tied for the the longest outing by a Cyclones pitcher this season.
- Has not walked more than two batters in any outing since July 7, 2008 with the DSL Mets against the DSL Blue Jays when he allowed three walks.
- Went 3-1 over his last four starts with the GCL Mets in 2010...Pitched at least 6.0 innings and allowed more than two runs only once.
- In 2009, went 7-1 as a starter with the DSL Mets...Did not allow more than three earned run in any of his 12 starts and allowed one earned or less in nine of 12... Pitched to a 1.74 (13 ERA / 67.1 IP) ERA.
