**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones took the series finale from the Tri-City ValleyCats on Thursday night, winning by the score of 7-4...**Tillman Pugh** went 3-4 with two RBI and stole two bases to pace the Brooklyn offense...**Jeff Walters** (3-6) collected the win after allowing three runs, none earned, in his 5.0 innings of work.

**CYCLONES VS. RENEGADES:** The Cyclones are 3-3 against Hudson Valley this season and 52-40 against the 'Gades all-time...Brooklyn is 2-1 at MCU Park and 1-2 at Dutchess Stadium.

**AT THE GAME TODAY:** Hurricane Irene has forced the cancellation of Sunday's game and turned this evening into a double header... The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Metro Card and card holder courtesy of Verizon...Following the game there will also be fireworks.

**NEXT HOME GAME:** Sunday's scheduled game was postponed due to Hurricane Irene... Those with tickets for that game can exchange them for any game during the remainder of the 2011 season based on the rain policy on the back of each ticket.

**PITCHING IN:** The Cyclones pitching staff ranks second in the NYPL in ERA at 3.15...They have allowed a league low 179 walks while ranking third in the league with 505 strikeouts... The 27 home runs allowed are tied for the third fewest in the league and the 239 runs allowed are the second fewest in the league.

**PLAYOFF PUSH:** Brooklyn comes into tonight 4.0 games behind SI and .002 percentage points ahead of WPT in the Wild Card.

**BACK IN BROWN:** **Brandon Brown** returned from the Disabled List on August 21st and has hit safely in each of his four starts since returning...Brown is hitting .438 (7-16) in these games.

**TILL-IS-THE-MAN:** After going 0-5 over his first two starts, outfielder **Tillman Pugh** is hit in four of his last five starts and is batting .444 (8-18) over this span.

**BRIAN'S STRUGGLES:** Cyclones infielder **Brian Harrison** is hitting just .077 (2-26) over his last eight games and have one hit in his last 18 at-bats...Harrison has just one multi-hit game since July 30th.

**RICHARD NOT RAKING:** Infielder **Richard Lucas** is batting just (3-25) over his last seven games and has seen his average drop from .313 to .291 over this span.

**TRANSACTIONS:** Following Thursday's game, infielder **Carlos Leyva** was assigned to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League...Outfielder and NYPL All-Star **Travis Taijeron** was activated from the Disabled List after recovering from an ankle injury.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** This season, when the Cyclones score five or more runs the team is 24-5...Conversely, when they score four runs or less the team is 12-23.

**NO BULL:** Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 77 runners and allowing only 19 of them to score (24.7%).

## GAME # 1 STARTER : LHP # 5 Chris Hilliard (3-1, 3.33 ERA)

- Made his first start in six weeks on August 21st vs. Tri-City...Had not pitched since July 11th at Connecticut because of a left elbow strain.
- Is the all-time Brooklyn Cyclones franchise leader in wins with 13...Went 9-1 with a 3.74 ERA in 14 starts for the 2010 Cyclones... Collected his first win in a three-game stint with the Cyclones in 2009.
- Is 2-0 against Hudson Valley this season, allowing five runs on 14 hits in 10.1 innings...For his career is 4-0 in four starts against the Renegades.
- Went 3-0 with a 2.93 ERA through his first three starts of the season from June 20th- 30th.
- Has limited leadoff hitters to a .154 (4-26) average.
- Six of his 12 runs allowed this season have come in the first inning of a game.
- Is 2-0 with a 0.72 ERA in 12.1 innings at home and 1-1 with a 5.52 ERA on the road this season.
