LAST GAME: Hurrican Irene forced the cancellation of Saturday and Sunday's games...On Friday, the Cyclones took both ends of a doubleheader from Hudson Valley, 7-4 and 3-0...In Game One, the Cyclones rallied from four runs down thanks to a bases clearing double from **Brandon Brown**...In Game Two, four Cyclones pitchers allowed only five hits.

CYCLONES VS. RENEGADES: The Cyclones are 5-3 against Hudson Valley this season and 54-40 against the 'Gades all-time...Brooklyn is 4-1 at MCU Park and 1-2 at Dutchess Stadium.

AT THE GAME TODAY: It's two games for the price of one with a doubleheader this evening...It's Garage Sale # 2 with fans having the chance to collect some of our most popular giveaway items from the past and Meet the Cyclones Monday after the game.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones will open their last series of the regular season on Friday against Staten Island...Friday means fireworks on Coney Island with the last show of the summer following the game.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones pitching staff ranks second in the NYPL in ERA at 3.15...They have allowed a league low 179 walks while ranking third in the league with 505 strikeouts...The 27 home runs allowed are tied for the third fewest in the league and the 239 runs allowed are the second fewest in the league.

PLAYOFF PUSH: Brooklyn comes into tonight 0.5 a game ahead of Williamsport for the Wild Card and 3.5 behind Staten Island in the race of the McNamara Division.

GET AHEAD: The Cyclones come into today's twin bill with a record of 23-5 when they score the first run of a game.

BACK IN BROWN: **Brandon Brown** returned from the Disabled List on August 21st and has hit safely in each of his five of his six starts since returning...Brown is hitting .409 (9-22) in these games.

DANDY DANNY: Shortstop **Danny Muno** currently has a six game hitting streak and has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games...He has scored a run in each of his last four games.

ICE COLE: First baseman **Cole Frenzel** is 2-18 over his last five games...Over his last 12 games, he has struck out 15 times.

BRIAN'S STRUGGLES: Cyclones infielder **Brian Harrison** is hitting just .103 (3-29) over the last ten games and has one hit in his last 17 at-bats...Harrison has just one multi-hit game since July 30th.

RICHARD NOT RAKING: Infielder **Richard Lucas** is batting just .156 (5-32) over his last nine games and has seen his average drop from .313 to .291 over this span.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: This season, when the Cyclones score five or more runs the team is 25-5...Conversely, when they score four runs or less the team is 13-23.

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 79 runners and allowing only 20 of them to score (25.3%).

GAME # 1 STARTER : RHP # 32 Marco Camarena (2-3, 3.30 ERA)

- Made his third start of the season against Hudson Valley on 7/1. Left the game in the fifth inning with a 3-1 lead, but did not factor into the decision.
- Is winless at home (0-3, 4.29 ERA, .278 BAA), but undefeated on the road (2-0, 1.66 ERA, .207 BAA)
- Was 0-3 with an ERA of 5.00 in six starts in July, but is 1-0 with an ERA of 1.77 in four starts in August.
- Has pitched to a 3.83 K/BB ratio, the best of all Cyclones starters.
- Allowed all four home runs this season in two consecutive starts. Previous to 7/18/11, had not allowed a home run since 8/17/09 while with the DSL Mets (R).
- Struck out a season-high eight batters in 4.2 innings of work on 8/17 vs. JAM.
- Has limited righthanders to a .221 batting average against and lefthanders to a .279 batting average against.
- Has pitched to a 1.20 WHIP and has held opponents to a .252 batting average this season.
