LAST GAME: The Cyclones won their fifth straight thanks to an 11-4 win over the Staten Island Yankees on Saturday night...**Brian Harrison** led the offensive charge with a 3-4 effort while driving in four runs...**Tillman Pugh** added a 3-5 effort and stole two bases...**Nelfi Zapata** returned to the lineup and went 2-5 with a run scored, home run and two RBI...**Ernesto Yanez** tossed 3.1 scoreless innings to collect his first save and **Steven Winnick** (4-0) got the win.

CYCLONES VS. YANKEES: The Cyclones are 8-5 against Staten Island this season and 72-67 overall against the Yankees...With their win last night Brooklyn won the season series against the Baby Bombers for the first time since 2008.

2011 VS. YANKEES: Shortstop **Danny Muno** is batting .387 (12-31) in eight games against Staten Island...The Cyclones are 6-2 against the Baby Bombers with Muno in the lineup and 2-3 without him...Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** is batting .444 (16-36) against the Yankees.

AT THE GAME TODAY: The Cyclones will close out the regular season on Sunday against Staten Island...It will be Fan Appreciation Day...Pre-Game fans are invited to have a catch on the field...Post-Game, kids will be allowed to run the bases.

DESIGN-A-BALL: The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a special baseball designed by Joshel Xiedeng from P.S. 101 or Bridget DeLuca from St. John the Baptist.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones will open the 2011 Playoffs against the Yankees at MCU Park on Tuesday.

DAN THE MAN: Shortstop **Danny Muno** currently has a 12-game hitting streak, the longest by a Cyclone this season...Over the span, he is hitting .450 (18-40)...Since August 5th, he has hit safely in 22 of 24 games...Over his last six games, the 8th rounder is batting .555 (10-18).

MORE ON MUNO: **Danny Muno** is second on the team with 43 runs scored and ranks fourth in the NYPL...Since July 31st, when Muno scores a run the Cyclones are 14-3...For the season, the team is 23-8 when he scores.

DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones currently lead the NYPL with a .972 team fielding percentage...In 73 games, they have committed a league-low 74 errors.

BRIAN'S BACK: Last night, **Brian Harrison** went 3-4 with three runs scored, a home run and four RBI...Harrison had gone without an RBI since August 7th and the three hits were his most since July 23rd vs. State College.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: This season, when the Cyclones score five or more runs the team is 27-5...Conversely, when they score four runs or less the team is 17-24.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The 2011 Cyclones have outscored their opponents 213-130 from the fifth inning on...Brooklyn is 25-10 when they score the last run of the game.

THE BATTLE FOR THE BRIDGE: So far this season, the Cyclones and Yankees have drawn 97,774 fans in the 13 games between the clubs...In 2008, the two teams combined to draw 107,312.
