## BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP # 29 Gabriel Ynoa (0-0, - . - - ERA)

- Is the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he is over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
- The fourth Opening Day starter from the Dominican Republic, joining Jorge Reyes (2006), Pedro P. Martinez (2008), and Yohan Almonte (2010).
- For his career, has walked only 12 batters in 128.1 innings of work...That is an average of 0.84 walks per nine innings.
- Has tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on two occasions (8/19/10 - DSL Mets vs. DSL Indians & 7/17/11 GCL Mets at GCL Astros).
- Has never struck out more than five batters in a game.
- Allowed a home run in the first inning of his first start in 2011 vs the GCL Nationals, and then did not allow another round tripper over his next 47.0 innings.
- For his career, has limited left handed batters to a .256 (42-164) average while righthanded hitters have combined to bat .253 (78-308).
