OPENING DAY: The Cyclones improved to 10-2 all-time on Opening Day, as well as 10-2 all-time in what was the first Opening Day shutout in franchise history. The Cyclones have not lost an Opening Day game since 2006 when they fell to the Staten Island Yankees 18-0...The Cyclones have opened the sea-

son against Staten Island nine times with Brooklyn going 8-1 in these games...Brooklyn defeated the Yankees 5-3 in Staten Island on Opening Day in 2011, but lost their home opener the following day by the score of 3-2.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Kevin Plawewcki (35th overall in 2012) become the Cyclones...It marks the second time in franchise history that more than one first round pick has been on the roster at the same time...In 2008, Ike Davis, Reese

VS. STATEN ISLAND: Brooklyn holds the all-time series advantage over the Staten Island Yankees, selected in the first 33 picks of that years draft. going 74-67 since 2001...Last season, Brooklyn went 9-5 against the Baby Bombers during the regular season.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: The Cyclones Opening Day roster features a record eight teenagers

GABRIEL YNOA: Made the Opening Day start for the Cyclones at only 19 years and 23 days old...He was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history.

WELCOME BACK RICH: For just the second time in franchise history, the Cyclones will have the same manager for consecutive seasons...Draft...Only four of these players are currently active season...Edgar Alfonzo is the only other manager to be at the helm for back-to-back seasons in 2007 and 2008.

FEELING A DRAFT: There are 11 players on the Cyclones roster who were selected in the 2012 MLB Draft...Only four of these players are currently active season...Edgar Alfonzo is the only other manager to be at the helm for back-to-back seasons in 2007 and 2008. All-Star game this evening in Charleston, SC...INF T.J. Rivera, OF Travis Tajeron, and LHP T.J. Chism from the 2011 Brooklyn Cyclones, will all play in the game.

SWEETHEART GOODBYE: On June 10th, long-time Voice of the Cyclones, Warner Fusselle, passed away...The Cyclones will be honoring Fusselle all season long by wearing a WF patch on the right sleeve of their home jerseys, with the initials separated by his trademark multi-color umbrella.

CALL HIM MAYBE: Cyclones infielder and former star of the Harvard Crimson baseball team Jeff Reynolds, was part of the viral video sensation involving the Harvard baseball team dancing to the hit song "Call Me Maybe"...At last count, the YouTube sensation

FINDING NIMMO: Brandon Nimmo, the first round selection in the 2011 MLB Draft, is the highest drafted player (13th overall) to play for the Cyclones...Cliff Floyd, who played with Brooklyn as a rehab assignment in 2006, was selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 14th round of the 1991 and Scott Kazmir was the 15th overall selection in the 2002 MLB Draft.

BACK IN THE NY GROOVE: Cyclones reliever as and Melville, NY native, John Mincone was originally selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 11th round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Suffolk County Community College, before signing as a minor league free agent this off season.
