LAST GAME: The Cyclones took their second consecutive game from the Yankees, winning 4-1 on Staten Island...Luis Mateo (1-0) struck out nine over 5.2 innings to collect the win...John Mincone and Jer-emy Gould combined for 3.1 perfect innings of relief to close out the game. Offensively, Cole Frenzel led the way with a 3-5 effort, scoring twice and driving in a run.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: Brooklyn holds the all-time series advantage over the Staten Island Yankees, going 75-67 since 2001...Last season, Brooklyn went 9-5 against the Baby Bombers during the regular season.

TWO FOR TWO: The Cyclones have opened the season by defeating the Yankees the first two games of the season in four of the last five years...Brooklyn and the Baby Bombers split the first two games of the season in 2011.

STAY HOT: The Cyclones have defeated the Yankees in seven straight regular season games dating August 7, 2011...Brooklyn defeated the Yankees on August 6th and 7th, and then took the final three games of the regular season from Staten Island.

PITCHING IN: Through the first two games of the season, the Cyclones pitching staff has limited the Yankees to only six hits in 59 at-bats for a .102 batting average...Cyclones hurlers have combined for 21 strikeouts and just two walks.

BULLS IN THE PEN: Cyclones relievers have allowed just one hit in 6.1 innings of work so far...Opponents are hitting just .050 (1-20) against the bullpen.

WELCOME BACK RICH: For just the second time in franchise history, the Cyclones will longtime manager Donnelly guided Brooklyn to a 45-39 record all season long by wearing a Wild Card appearance in the playoffs last season...Edgar Alfonzo is the only other manager to be at the helm for back-to-back seasons in 2007 and 2008.

COLE IS RAKING: Cyclones first baseman Cole Frenzel tied his career-high with three hits on Tuesday...It marked the third time in his career that he has collected three hits after also reaching the milestone on August 18th vs. Jamestown and September 1st at Lowell.

TRANSACTIONS: Following last night's game, INF Yucy De La Cruz and C Xorge Carrillo were transferred to Savannah (A) of the South Atlantic League...INF Jeff Reynolds was added to the Cyclones active roster.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: The Cyclones Opening Day roster featured a record eight teenagers on the squad...During the entire 2011 season, there were only three players in their teens who suited up for the Cyclones.

CALL HIM MAYBE: Cyclones infielder and former star of the Harvard Crimson baseball team Jeff Reynolds, was part of the viral video sensation involving the Harvard baseball team dancing to the hit song "Call Me Maybe"...At last count, the YouTube sensation had nearly 13 million views.

SWEETHEART GOODBYE: On June 10th, Warner Fusselle, the Cyclones, will be honoring Fusselle by his trademark multi-color umbrella.
