**PITCHING IN:** The Cyclones lead the NYPL in Brooklyn...The former Arizona Wildcat had nine multi-ERA with a 2.66 (21 ER / 71.0 IP)...They are also tied with Vermont for the league lead with 75 strikeouts and have walked only 20 batters, second fewest in the league...In 71.0 innings, Brooklyn pitching has surrendered a league-low 48 hits.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to this evening's game, the Cyclones activated RHP Tim Peterson, the Mets 20th round selection from the University of Kentucky...The Mets also announced that RHP Rich Ruff has been granted his release...In addition, RHP Logan Taylor, the Mets 11th round selection in the 2012 draft, has joined the squad but remains inactive.

**START ME UP:** Through the first eight games of the season, Cyclones starting pitchers are 5-1 with a 1.59 ERA (seven ER /39.2 IP)...No starting pitcher has allowed more than two earned runs in any outing.

**SWEETHEART GOODBYE:** On June 10th, longtime Voice of the Cyclones, Warner Fusselle, who has passed away...The Cyclones will be honoring Fusselle all season long by wearing a WF patch on the right sleeve of their home jerseys, with the initials separated by his trademark multi-color umbrella.
