LAST GAME: Two errors and a wild pitch in the seventh inning led to three unearned runs as the Cyclones have allowed 27 runs all season and 19 of Brooklyn Cyclones fell to Hudson Valley 4-2 on Tuesday them coming have scored in the seventh inning. evening...Dawrin Frias (1-2) suffered the hard luck loss after being charged with the three unearned runs...Eudy Pina continued his hot hitting with a 2-for-4 effort and collected his team-leading 10th RBI of the season.

NOT SO MAGNIFICENT SEVEN: This year, the Cyclones have allowed 27 runs all season and 19 of them going for extra bases.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones are tied for second in the NYPL with five home runs...Four of these five home runs have come in road games.

HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn holds the all-time series advantage over the Hudson Valley Renegades 56-42 since the franchises inception in 2001...Last year, the Cyclones took the season series, 6-4.

EXTRA EXTRA: Eudy Pina, who is second in the NYPL with 10 RBI, has nine hits this season with five home runs.

ON THE BENCH: Cyclones catcher Kevin Plawecki will be away for the next two days as he attends the Johnny Bench Award ceremony in Wichita, KS...Plawecki is one of three finalists along with Mitchell Garver from New Mexico and Mike Zunino from the University of Florida...The winner will be announced tomorrow at the Greater Wichita Sports Banquet.

PINA POWER: The Cyclones outfielder currently has a three-game hitting streak and has collected at least one RBI in each of these games as well.

IRON MEN: There are 14 players in the NYPL who have played in every game this season, and three of them are on the Cyclones - Eudy Pina, Phillip Evans, and Brandon Nimmo - and have started all nine games.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones lead the NYPL in ERA with a 2.51 (22 ER / 79.0 IP)...They also lead the league with 81 strikeouts and have walked only 23 batters, third fewest in the league...In 79.0 innings, Brooklyn pitching has surrendered a league-low 55 hits.

COLE IS RAKING: Cole Frenzel is hitting .385 through his first seven games of the season...In those seven starts, he has compiled four multi-hit games for Brooklyn and has hit safely in five of the seven games...The former Arizona Wildcat had nine multi-hit games in 43 contests with Brooklyn in 2011.

WALK THIS WAY: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with 51 walks through the first nine games of the season...No other team has walked more than 43 times... Brandon Nimmo leads the NYPL with 11 base-on-balls.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to last night's game, the Cyclones activated RHP Tim Peterson, the Mets 20th round selection from the University of Kentucky...The Mets also announced that RHP Rich Ruff has been granted his release...In addition, RHP Logan Taylor, a Mets 11th round selection in the 2012 draft, has joined the squad but remains inactive.

START ME UP: Through the first nine games of the season, Cyclones starting pitchers are 5-1 with a 1.61 ERA (eight ER / 44.2 IP)...No starting pitcher has allowed more than two earned runs in any outing.

SWEETHEART GOODBYE: On June 10th, longtime Voice of the Cyclones, Warner Fusselle, the only NYPL who has reached base in every game this season...Although he is hitting just .167, he has a .405 all season long by wearing a WF patch on the right sleeve of their home jerseys, with the initials separated by his trademark multi-color umbrella.

GETTING ON EVERY DAY: Brandon Nimmo is the long-time Voice of the Cyclones, Warner Fusselle, the only NYPL who has reached base in every game this season...Although he is hitting just .167, he has a .405 all season long by wearing a WF patch on the right sleeve of their home jerseys, with the initials separated by his trademark multi-color umbrella.
