**LAST GAME:** The IronBirds took advantage of three Cyclones errors and some uncharacteristic wild-**GETTING ON EVERY DAY:** Cyclones outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** is one of two players who have nessed from the Cyclones hurlers en route to a 5-2 win reached base safely in all 11 games this year...Although on Thursday night...**Matt Koch** (0-1) suffered the loss he is hitting just .167, he has a .400 on-base percentage in his professional debut after he was unexpectedly and leads the league in walks with 13 through the first given the start...**Juan Gamboa** went 2-for-3 with a 11 games of the season. run scored and a pair of walks to lead the Cyclones offensive effort.

**VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a 67-36 all-time record against Aberdeen... The 2012 series is tied 2-2 through four games...The Cyclones went 8-2 against Aberdeen during the 2011 season

**HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE:** Before last night's Aberdeen victory, the IronBirds had not won a game in Brooklyn since July 28, 2009...Brooklyn was 5-0 against Aberdeen at MCU Park in 2010 and 2011.

**ON THE BENCH:** Cyclones catcher **Kevin Plawecki** returns to Brooklyn today after missing the last two games while attending the Johnny Bench Award banquet in Wichita, Kansas...Plawecki was one of three finalists for the award which was won by the University of Florida's Mike Zunino.

**PITCHING IN:** The Cyclones rank second in the NYPL with a 2.51 ERA (27 ER / 97.0 innings)...They have allowed a league-low 71 hits and 33 runs.

**WALK THIS WAY:** The Cyclones lead the NYPL with 62 walks through the first 11 games of the year...No other team has walked more than 50 times...The Lowell (31), State College (31) and Connecticut (26).

**JUAN IS ON:** Since returning from an ankle injury, which he sustained on June 22nd, **Juan Gamboa** has hit .500 (3-6) and has reached base safely in six of his nine plate appearances...Gamboa started the season 1-15 through his first four games.

**NOT SO MAGNIFICENT SEVEN:** This year, the Cyclones have allowed 33 runs all season and 19 of them have been scored in the seventh inning.

**IRON MEN:** There are 11 players in the NYPL who have played in every game this season, and three of them are on the Cyclones - **Eudy Pina, Phillip Evans,** and **Brandon Nimmo** - and have started all 11 games.

**WHO'S HOT:** Firstbaseman **Cole Frenzel** is batting .467 (7-13) over the last five games with three runs scored and three RBI...For the season, Frenzel's .486 on-base percentage ranks him third in the entire New York-Penn League.

**WHO'S NOT:** Cyclones outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** snapped an 0-for-17 with his single in the eighth last night...**Richie Rodriguez** is 0-for-16 dating to the second inning on June 23rd...His last hit was a double off of tonight's starter Cameron Coffey.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to yesterday's game, INF **Alex Sanchez** was placed on the Seven-Day Disabled List with a left hip flexor...The Cyclones activated **Jorge Rivero**...In addition, the Mets came to terms with sixth-round selection **Jayce Boyd**, who joined the team but is not yet active.

**SWEETHEART GOODBYE:** On June 10th, longtime Voice of the Cyclones, Warner Fusselle, has passed away...The Cyclones will be honoring Fusselle all season long by wearing a WF patch on the right sleeve of their home jerseys, with the initials separated by his trademark multi-color umbrella.

- Made his 2012 debut on June 23rd at Aberdeen...Collected the win after tossing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing only two hits while walking two and striking out four.
- Was the primary closer for the GCL Mets in 2011...Went 1-2 with six saves in 16 relief appearances in the Gulf Coast League.
- In 24.1 innings, allowed seven runs, six earned, on 23 hits while walking seven and striking out 18.
- His longest relief outing of the year came on August 3, 2011 vs. the GCL Cardinals...Tossed 4.1 innings allowing just one hit.
- Spent the 2010 campaign as a starting pitcher with the DSL Mets...Went 4-2 with a 1.97 ERA in 14 games, 12 starts....Struck out 51 and walked 13 in 64.0 innings.
