VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with an all-time record of 59-42 against the Hudson Valley Renegades...Brooklyn leads the 2012 series, 4-1...In five games against the Renegades, **Eudy Pina** is batting .444 (8-18) with six RBI and **IB Cole Frenzel** is hitting .421 (8-19) with four runs scored.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones are second in the NYPL with a 2.47 ERA (37 ER/135.0 IP)...They have allowed a league-low 93 hits (no other team has allowed less than 113) and struck out a league-high 139 batters...Their 43 runs allowed are lowest in the league.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Last night, Cyclones pitchers combined to issue 12 base-on-balls, the highest total by any team in the NYPL this season...The all-time franchise record is 13 walks, a feat accomplished twice, most recently on July 29, 2008 at Vermont...Prior to last night's game Cyclones hurlers had walked only 33 batters in 124.0 innings.

FRONT AND CENTER: Last night's home run from OF **Eudy Pina** was only the fifth home run hit out of MCU Park to centerfield since 2001...Prior to last night's home run, a solo shot from Vermont's Russell Moldenhauer on 9/1/10 was the most recent.

STEF'IN IT UP: Cyclones outfielder **Stefan Sabol** is currently riding an eight-game hitting streak that has raised his batting average from .154 (2-13) on June 22nd to .317 (13-41) coming into today's action...During his hitting streak, he is batting .393 (11-28)...The 17th round pick in the 2012 Draft is batting .444 (8-18) against lefthanders.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **IB Cole Frenzel** is off to a hot start, ranking third in the NYPL with a .404 (19-47) average...The former Arizona Wildcat is hitting .533 (8-15) against left-handed pitching this season, after hitting just .154 (4-26) against southpaws during the 2011 season.

PLAWECKI'S PAW: Cyclones catcher **Kevin Plawecki** was hit on the left hand in the 11th inning of last night's game...The supplemental first round pick went for x-rays this morning which revealed no additional damage...He is considered day-to-day.

START ME UP: Cyclones starting pitchers this year are a combined 7-2 with a 1.85 ERA (15 ER / 73.0 IP)...In 15 games this season, only once has a starting pitcher allowed more than two runs...In addition in 13 of these 15 outings the starting pitcher has gone at least 5.0 innings...The opposition is hitting just .192 (93-484) against the Cyclones pitching staff as a whole.

IRON MEN: There are sive players in the NYPL who have played in every game this season, and two of them are on the Cyclones - **Eudy Pina** and **Phillip Evans** and have started all 15 games.
