LAST GAME: The Cyclones had their six-game winning streak snapped with a 5-4 loss on Thursday night... .281 (57-203) against left-handed pitching this season... **Rainy Lara** (2-1) suffered the loss after allowing four runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings... **Juan Gamboa** connected on his first home run of the season and went 2-5... Williamsport scored the eventual winning run in the seventh on an RBI single from Larry Greene, Jr.

ALRIGHT VS. LEFT: The Cyclones are hitting .281 (57-203) against left-handed pitching this season... In games started by left-handed pitching, the Cyclones are 6-1 this season.

VS. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with an all-time record of 35-25 against the Williamsport Crosscutters... The teams shared the 2001 NYPL title, and also met in the 2003 NYPL finals.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: The Cyclones have committed eight errors in their last two games after scoring on the play, did not touch home plate when trying to avoid a tag from Cyclones catcher **Jeff Glenn**. committed eight errors in their last two games after committing only five errors in their previous seven contests... For the season, Brooklyn has been charged with 24 errors with 33% of them coming in the last two games.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones pitching staff ranks third in the NYPL with a 2.72 ERA... In 162.0 innings they have allowed just 58 runs, 49 earned... The Cyclones lead the NYPL with 165 strikeouts and have allowed a league-low 125 hits.

GET 'EM IN: **IB Cole Frenzel** leads the team with a .538 (7-13) average with runners in scoring position... In 13 at-bats with RISP, Frenzel has collected 10 RBI... With RISP and two outs, Frenzel's average improves to .571 (4-7) with five RBI.

STEP'IN IT UP: Cyclones outfielder **Stefan Sabo** is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak that has raised his batting average from .154 (2-13) on June 22nd to .352 (19-54) coming into today's action... During his hitting streak, he is batting .415 (17-41)... He is the 26th player in franchise history to have a hitting streak of at least 10 games.

BULLS IN THE PEN: Over the last six games, the Cyclones bullpen has allowed just five earned runs in 25.1 innings of work for an ERA of 1.78.

RED HOT COLE: Cyclones **IB Cole Frenzel** ranks third in the NYPL with a .400 (24-60) batting average... He is also tied for third in the league with 24 hits, second in triples (2), third in slugging percentage (.583) and fifth in on-base percentage (.471)... The former Arizona Wildcat has reached base safely in 12 straight games and has eight RBI in his last seven games.

HOME COOKIN': As a team, the Cyclones are batting .268 (89-332) in 10 games at MCU Park... On the road, they are hitting .224 (60-268) in eight contests... **SS Phillip Evans** is batting .341 (14-41) at home and .129 (4-31) on the road.

RBI LEADERS: Outfielders **Brandon Nimmo** and **Eudy Pina** are tied for fourth in the NYPL with 13 RBI... For Nimmo, 10 of his 13 RBI have come in his last six games.

IRON MAN: Cyclones shorstop **Phillip Evans** is one of only three players in the NYPL that has played in all 18 games this season... Williamsport's Chris Serritella, and John Wooten from the Lake Monsters are the other two players.

COACHING CHANGE: Cyclones pitching coach **Marc Valdes** will be away from the team for the weekend as he attends a family event... While he is gone, **Ron Romanick**, pitching coordinator for the New York Mets, will serve as the pitching coach for the Cyclones.

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP # 29 GABRIEL YNOA (1-0, 2.00 ERA)

- Right handed hitters are batting just .086 (3-35) against Ynoa...Has allowed just two hits with runners on-base all season.
- Struck out a career-high six batters on June 30th vs. Aberdeen.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
- The fourth Opening Day starter from the Dominican Republic, joining Jorge Reyes (2006), Pedro P. Martinez (2008), and Yohan Almonte (2010).
- For his career, has walked only 14 batters in 146.1 innings of work...That is an average of 0.86 walks per nine innings.
- Has tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on two occasions (8/19/10 - DSL Mets vs. DSL Indians & 7/17/11 GCL Mets at GCL Astros).
- Allowed a home run in the first inning of his first start in 2011 vs the GCL Nationals, and then did not allow another round tripper over his next 47.0 innings.
