LAST GAME: The Cyclones lost their second straight game to the Jamestown Jammers, assuring their last in the NYPL in batting with runners in scoring first series loss of the year, falling 5-2 on Sunday evening...**Jayce Boyd** continued his hot hitting, going 2-3, league with a .297 (55-185) batting average with RISP. with an RBI, but the Cyclones were only able to collect five hits overall...**Luis Cessa** (1-1) was charged with the loss, allowing two runs on four hits over 5.2... over his first five games, **Juan Gamboa** has hit safely Cessa allowed a home run for the first time since July 12, 2011.

SCORING TROUBLES: The Cyclones rank in eighth in the NYPL in scoring with runners in scoring position, batting just .209 (44-211)...Tri-City leads the league with a .297 (55-185) batting average with RISP. with an RBI, but the Cyclones were only able to collect five hits overall...**Luis Cessa** (1-1) was charged with the loss, allowing two runs on four hits over 5.2... over his first five games, **Juan Gamboa** has hit safely Cessa allowed a home run for the first time since July 12, 2011.

VS. JAMESTOWN: The Cyclones come into this evening's game with an all-time record of 20-15 against the Jamestown Jammers...The teams also met in the 2010 NYPL Playoffs with Brooklyn winning the series 2-1...The first game in Cyclones history was played in Jamestown on June 19, 2001 with Brooklyn winning 2-1.

GO-GO GAMBOA: After starting the season 1-15 in eight of his last nine contests and is hitting .316 (12-38) over this stretch to raise his batting average from .067 to .245.

STEP'IN IT UP: Cyclones outfielder **Stefan Sabol** has reached base safely in 17 of his 18 appearances this season...Over his last 14 games, he is batting .358 (19-53)...The 17th round pick in the 2012 MLB Draft has his safely in 13 of these 14 games.

KEVIN PLawecki: Has hit safely in each of his last four starts and is batting .357 (5-14) over the stretch...He is also the only Cyclones catcher who has thrown out a would-be base stealer (6-19).

BULLS IN THE PEN: Over the last nine games, the Cyclones bullpen has allowed just nine earned runs in 36.2 innings of work for an ERA of 2.21...Prior to last night's game, the bullpen had not allowed more than a single run in a game since July 3rd.

NOT SO HOT: Since returning from the disabled list with a hip flexor on July 5th, **Alex Sanchez** has gone 1-18 (.056)...Prior to the injury, the infielder was batting .394 (13-33)...Shortstop **Phillip Evans** is 0-15 since collecting a single in his first at-bat on July 4th and is just 2-21 (.095) over his last five games.

STARTING IS STOPPING: Through the first 14 games of the season, Cyclones starting pitching had gone 7-2 with a 1.85 ERA (15 earned runs / 73.0 innings) and allowed more than two earned runs in a start only once...Over the last seven games, Brooklyn starters have gone 1-2 with a 6.19 ERA (25 earned runs / 36.1 innings) and have allowed more than two earned run in five of these seven games.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game ranked second in the NYPL with a .969 fielding percentage...In 801 total chances, they have committed a league-low 25 errors...Of these 25 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport earlier this week July 4th & 5th.

GET 'EM IN: Cyclones outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** is currently tied for third in the NYPL with 15 RBI...For the 19-year-old, 12 of these RBI have come in his last nine games.

FUTURES GAME: Former Cyclone **Wilmer Flores**, the youngest player to ever suit up for the Cyclones, participated in the XM Radio Futures Game in Kansas City yesterday...Flores went 0-2 while starting at third base for the World Team...Team USA defeated the World Team, 17-5.
