### BROOKLYN CYCLONES (14-8) vs. CONNECTICUT TIGERS (6-16)

**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones were swept by the Jamestown Jammers, losing the series finale on tonight's game just 1-13 over his last three starts... Monday by the score of 5-2...**Matt Bowman** (1-1) Over this span he has struck out seven times after was tagged with the loss after allowing the tying and stirring out just four times through his first 59 at-bats go ahead runs to score in the eighth...**Phillip Evans** of the year in 16 games. Snapped an 0-17 slump with a two-RBI single to provide all the offense the Cyclones could muster.

**VS. CONNECTICUT:** The Cyclones come into in nine of his last 10 contests and is hitting .325 (13- this evening's game with an all-time record of 7-5 40) over this stretch to raise his batting average from against the Connecticut Tigers...The team moved from .067 to .255. Oneonta, NY to Norwich, CT prior to the 2010 season.

**LOSING STREAK:** The Cyclones are currently riding their first-three game losing streak of the 2012 campaign...The Cyclones have not lost four games in a row since July 1-4, 2010.

**STARTING IS STOPPING:** Through the first 14 games of the season, Cyclones starting pitching had gone 7-2 with a 1.85 ERA (15 earned runs / 73.0 innings) and allowed more than two earned runs in a start only once...Over the last eight games, Brooklyn starters have gone 1-2 with a 5.62 ERA (26 earned runs / 41.2 innings) and have allowed more than two earned run in five of these eight games.

**FINDING NIMMO:** The Cyclones OF **Brandon Nimmo** has hit safely in five of his last six games...He has also collected 12 RBI in his last 10 games...Nimmo also leads the NYPL with 19 walks in his 21 games.

**SCORING TROUBLES:** The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL in batting with runners in scoring position, batting just .205 (45-220)...Tri-City leads the league with a .291 (57-196) batting average with RISP... State College ranks 13th in the league at .228 (44-193)...Over their last seven games, the Cyclones are hitting .200 (16-80) with RISP...**Cole Frenzel** (.421 (8-19) and **Eudy Pina** (.316, 6-19) are the only players on the team hitting above .300 with RISP.

**GO-GO GAMBOA:** After starting the season 1-15 over his first five games, **Juan Gamboa** has hit safely in nine of his last 10 contests and is hitting .325 (13- this evening's game with an all-time record of 7-5 40) over this stretch to raise his batting average from against the Connecticut Tigers...The team moved from .067 to .255. Oneonta, NY to Norwich, CT prior to the 2010 season.

**JAYCE IN THE CLUTCH:** In at-bats during innings one through four, **Jayce Boyd** is batting just .182 (2-13)...From the fifth inning on, the former Florida State Seminole is batting .444 (8-18) with three runs scored and four RBI.

**KEVIN PLawecki:** Has hit safely in each of his last four starts and is batting .357 (5-14) over the stretch...He is also the only Cyclones catcher who has thrown out more than one would-be base stealer (6-19).

**NOT SO HOT:** Since returning from the disabled list with a hip flexor on July 5th, **Alex Sanchez** has gone 1-19 (.053)...Prior to the injury, the infielder was batting .394 (13-33)...Shortstop **Phillip Evans** is just 1-16 (.063) over his last four games.

**THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS:** The Cyclones come into tonight's game ranked second in the NYPL with a .970 fielding percentage...In 837 total chances, they have committed a league-low 25 errors...Of these 25 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport on July 4th & 5th.

**TRANSACTIONS:** INF **Jorge Rivero** and OF **Julion Concepcion** were transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League...RHP **Logan Taylor** was added to the active roster.
