LAST GAME: The Cyclones lost their fourth straight on Wednesday night, falling to the Connecticut Tigers 1-0...The Cyclones collected only four hits in the position, batting just .200 (45-225)...Tri-City leads game, but had runners in scoring position with nobody the league with a .288 (60-208) batting average with out and failed to score...**Julian Hilario** (0-1) was the hard luck loser, allowing one run on six hits over his 6.0 (51-221)...Over their last eight games, the Cyclones innings of work...**Alex Sanchez** went 2-3 and was the only Cyclone to collect multiple hits in the game. 6-19) are the only players on the team hitting above .300 with RISP.

VS. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones come into this evening's game with an all-time record of 7-6 against the Connecticut Tigers...The team moved from Oneonta, NY to Norwich, CT prior to the 2010 season.

LOSING STREAK: The Cyclones are currently riding their longest losing streak of the 2012 campaign...The Cyclones had not lost four games in a row since July 1-4, 2010...The last time the Cyclones lost five games in a row was 2008 from July 7-12.

STARTING IS STOPPING: Through the first 14 games of the season, Cyclones starting pitching had gone 7-2 with a 1.85 ERA (15 earned runs / 73.0 innings) and allowed more than two earned runs in a start only once...Over the last nine games, Brooklyn starters have gone 1-3 with a 5.10 ERA (27 earned runs / 47.2 innings) and have allowed more than two earned run in five of these nine games.

NOT SO HOT: As a team, the Cyclones are batting just .165 (28-170) over the last five games...In the last 10 games, they are batting .207 (72-346)...Over there last 10 games, there are no Cyclones who are batting over .300...After going 1-4 last night, Brooklyn SS **Philip Evans** is now 2-20 (.100) over his last five games.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game ranked second in the NYPL with a .971 fielding percentage...In 872 total chances, they have committed a league-low 25 errors...Of these 25 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport on July 4th & 5th.

SCORING TROUBLES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the league at .231 with four runs scored, two doubles and two RBI on the road and .138 (4-29) at MCU Park.

ALEX ON THE ROAD: Cyclones infielder **Alex Sanchez** has hit safely in all six road games that he has played in this season...Sanchez is batting .462 (12-26) with four runs scored, two doubles and two RBI on the road and .138 (4-29) at MCU Park.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with eight stolen bases this season...There are four teams in the league who have been thrown out stealing more times than the Cyclones have attempted a stolen bases.

K IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL in strikeouts with 212...Vermont is second in the league with 189 punchouts.

TRANSACTIONS: INF **Cole Frenzel** was transferred to Savannah (A) of the South Atlantic League...INF **Jeff Reynolds** was added to the active roster.

SHUTOUTS: Last night was the first time the Cyclones were shutout during the 2012 season...The Cyclones are tied with State College with three shut-out wins on the year...In 2011, Brooklyn was shutout four times.

- Is tied for fifth in the NYPL with 23 strikeouts on the season.
- Struck out 10 batters in his start on June 29th vs. Aberdeen...Became the 22nd pitcher in franchise history to reach double digit K's and the first since A.J. Pina on 8/12/10.
- Made his 2012 debut on June 23rd at Aberdeen...Collected the win after tossing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing only two hits while walking two and striking out four.
- Was the primary closer for the GCL Mets in 2011...Went 1-2 with six saves in 16 relief appearances in the Gulf Coast League.
- His longest relief outing of the year came on August 3, 2011 vs. the GCL Cardinals...Tossed 4.1 innings allowing just one hit.
- Spent the 2010 campaign as a starting pitcher with the DSL Mets...Went 4-2 with a 1.97 ERA in 14 games, 12 starts...Struck out 51 and walked 13 in 64.0 innings.
