LAST GAME: The Cyclones dropped the first game of a quick two-game set to the Hudson Valley Renegades 4-1 on Tuesday night...RHP **Julian Hilario** (0-2) batting .500 (10-20) over this stretch...Nimmo has been tagged with the loss after allowing four runs on five hits over his 3.1 innings...RHP **Ernesto Yanez**, RHP

Matt Koch, and RHP **Logan Taylor** combined for 5.2 innings of spotless relief, but the damage was done... **Edy Pina** is tied for second in the league with four OF **Brandon Nimmo** had the lone RBI for the Cyclones with a double in the sixth inning.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones come into this evening's game with an all-time record of 60-43 against Hudson Valley...This year, the Cyclones hold a 5-2 advantage over their division rival.

START ME UP: Over the last eight games, Cyclones starting pitchers have allowed just 11 earned runs over 45.1 innings for a 2.18 ERA.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 17-3 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 17 wins are the most in the NYPL.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .974 fielding percentage...In 1108 total chances, they have committed a league-low 29 errors...Of these 29 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport on July 4th & 5th...Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** leads all NYPL shortstops with a .974 fielding percentage...He has committed just four errors in 155 total chances...Outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** also leads all NYPL outfielders with a 1.000 fielding percentage...He has yet to commit an error in 57 total chances.

SCORING TROUBLES: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL in batting with runners in scoring position, batting just .219 (61-279)...Williamsport is ranked 13th in the NYPL at .226 (78-345)...Over their last seven games, Brooklyn is batting 16-59 (.271) with RISP.

FINDING NIMMO: Cyclones OF **Brandon Nimmo** has hit safely in five straight games and is batting .500 (10-20) over this stretch...Nimmo has been tagged with the loss after allowing four runs on five hits over his 3.1 innings...RHP **Ernesto Yanez**, RHP

AN ASSIST FROM EUDY: Cyclones outfielder **Edy Pina** is tied for second in the league with four OF **Brandon Nimmo** had the lone RBI for the Cyclones with a double in the sixth inning.

STEP'IN OUT: Cyclones OF **Stefan Sabol** has reached base in 13 consecutive road games this season...Over this span he is batting .304 (14-46) with nine walks.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with 10 stolen bases this season...There are three individual players in the NYPL who have stolen as many bases as the Cyclones team.

HIT OR MISS: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with a .231 (224-969) team batting average...They also lead the league with 138 walks...Brooklyn has struck out 189 times, second fewest in the league...Over the last 10 games, Brooklyn is batting just .207 (68-329) and has gone 4-6 in these games.

K IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL in strikeouts with 253...Vermont is second in the league with 242 punchouts...RHP **Luis Mateo** leads the league with 38 strikeouts, while RHP **Rainy Lara** ranks third with 31 K's.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: RHP **Luis Mateo** was named the NYPL Pitcher of the Week for the period of July 9th-16th...It is the second time this season that Mateo has been honored with the award...He becomes just the second player in franchise history to be honored as the Pitcher/Player of the Week in the same season, and the first since **Frank Corr** was honored twice during the 2001 season.

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP # 40 RAINY LARA (3-1, 2.91 ERA)

- Is third in the New York-Penn League with 31 strikeouts this season
- Righthanded hitters are batting just .103 (4-39) against him.
- Struck out 10 batters in his start on June 29th vs. Aberdeen...Became the 22nd pitcher in franchise history to reach double digit K's and the first since A.J. Pinera on 8/12/10.
- Made his 2012 debut on June 23rd at Aberdeen...Collected the win after tossing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing only two hits while walking two and striking out four.
- Was the primary closer for the GCL Mets in 2011...Went 1-2 with six saves in 16 relief appearances in the Gulf Coast League.
- His longest relief outing of the year came on August 3, 2011 vs. the GCL Cardinals...Tossed 4.1 innings allowing just one hit.
- Spent the 2010 campaign as a starting pitcher with the DSL Mets...Went 4-2 with a 1.97 ERA in 14 games, 12 starts...Struck out 51 and walked 13 in 64.0 innings.
- Longest outings of his career were back-to-back 7.0 inning starts on August 9 & August 14, 2010...Allowed only one run and a combined six hits in these outings.
