VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones come into today's game with a record of 69-36 against the IronBirds all-time...This season Brooklyn has gone 4-2 including 2-1 at MCU Park...Since 2010, Brooklyn has gone 12-1 against Aberdeen at MCU Park.

HOME NOT SO SWEET HOME: The Cyclones snapped a five-game home losing streak with their 2-1 victory on Sunday night...The five game home losing skid was the longest since the 2005 season when the Cyclones lost a franchise record six straight home games over the period of July 5th-15th.

START ME UP: Over the last 13 games, Cyclones starting pitchers have allowed just 19 earned runs over 75.1 innings for a 2.27 ERA.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 20-4 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 20 wins are the most in the NYPL... During the entire 2011 season, Brooklyn scored first in 31 games, and won 25 of them.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Last night, the Cyclones grounded into a pair of double plays giving them 35 double plays on the season through the first 34 games of the season...The 35 twin-killings are the most in the New York-Penn League...In 2011, Brooklyn ranked second in the league with 63 ground into double plays.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones relief corps have committed a league-low 32 errors...Of these 32 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport on July 4th & 5th...Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans**, 3B **Dimas Ponce** and OF **Brandon Nimmo** all lead their positions in fielding percentage.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .976 fielding percentage...In 1335 total chances, they have committed a league-low 32 errors...Of these 32 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport on July 4th & 5th...Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans**, 3B **Dimas Ponce** and OF **Brandon Nimmo** all lead their positions in fielding percentage.

EVANS WITHOUT AN E: After committing four errors through his first 17 games of the season, **Phillip Evans** has not committed an error in his last 16 games...The 19-year-old leads all NYPL shortstops with a .978 fielding percentage hand has committed just four errors in 179 total chances.

SCORING TROUBLES: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL in batting with runners in scoring position, batting just .206 (68-330)...During their most recent series, against the Yankees, Brooklyn hit just .136 (6-44).

WHO'S HOT: Outfielder **Eudy Pina** is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak and is batting .429 (12-28) over this span...Catcher **Kevin Plawecki** is hitting .409 (9-22) over his last five games.

WHO'S NOT: Cyclones Outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** comes into tonight's game just 1-for-16 over his last four games with 11 strikeouts during this span...Catcher **Nelfi Zapata** is 0-for-25 dating to June 28th.
