LAST GAME: The Cyclones continued their recent slump with their seventh loss in their last eight home games thanks a 6-3 defeat at the hands of the IronBirds...**Tim Peterson** (1-1) suffered the loss after allowing three runs, earned, on four hits in errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against 0.2 inning...The Cyclones went 1-for-8 with RISP and collected only five hits.

VS. BATAVIA: The Cyclones come into today's game with an all-time record of 27-9 against the Muckdogs...The Cyclones went 2-1 against the Muckdogs in 2011.

ROAD WARRIORS: Brooklyn is 12-5 in road games with season...The 12 road wins are the most of any team in the NYPL behind Tri-City's 14 road victories...As a team, Brooklyn has pitched to a 1.99 ERA (34 ER/154.0 IP) on the road and a 3.39 (67 ER / 178.0 IP) at MCU Park.

THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 18-3 when they score three or more runs, and are 3-12 when they score two runs or less.

START ME UP: Over the last 15 games, Cyclones starting pitchers have allowed just 23 earned runs over 87.1 innings for a 2.37 ERA.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 20-5 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 20 wins are the most in the NYPL...During the entire 2011 season, Brooklyn scored first in 31 games, and won 25 of them.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Yesterday, the Cyclones grounded into a pair of double plays giving them 41 double plays on the season through the first 36 games of the season...The 41 twin-killings are the most in the New York-Penn League...There are 10 teams in the NYPL who have hit into 24 double plays or less...The Cyclones have hit into 10 double plays in their last five games.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones have committed a league-low 33 errors...Of these 33 errors, eight of them came in back-to-back games against Williamsport on July 4th & 5th...Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans**, 1B **Jayce Boyd** and OF **Brandon Nimmo** all lead their positions in fielding percentage.

EVANS WITHOUT AN E: After committing four errors through his first 17 games of the season, **Phillip Evans** has not committed an error in his last 17 games...The 19-year-old leads all NYPL shortstops with a .979 fielding percentage and has committed just four errors in 189 total chances.

SCORING TROUBLES: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL in batting with runners in scoring position, batting just .201 (69-344)...Over their last six games, Brooklyn is hitting just .121 (7-58) with RISP... Over their last six games, spanning 62.0 innings, the Cyclones have scored just nine runs and are batting .215 (48-223) as a team.

NOT SO HOT: Cyclones Outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** comes into tonight's game just 3-for-23 over his last six games with 13 strikeouts during this span...Catcher **Nelfi Zapata** is 0-for-29 dating to June 28th...**Juan Gamboa** is 1-20 over his last five games...**Stefan Sabol** is batting .167 (7-42) over his last 11 games with an at-bat...1B **Jayce Boyd** is batting .111 (2-18) over his last five games.

ALRIGHT VS. LEFT: In games started by left-handed pitching, the Cyclones are 8-3 this season...In 395 at-bats against southpaws, Brooklyn has hit nine home runs...By comparison, in 832 at-bats against righthanders, the Cyclones also have eight home runs.

POWER FAILURE: Prior to yesterday's game, the Cyclones had allowed 12 home runs, second fewest in the league...Aberdeen hit three home runs on Tuesday.

- Right handed hitters are batting just .136 (9-66) against Ynoa...Is third in the NYPL with a 0.81 WHIP and is third in baserunners per nine innings at 7.50.
- For his career, has walked only 17 batters in 164.1 innings of work.
- In jst start on July 19th at Staten Island, allowed a leadoff double and then did not allow another hit for the rest of the game.
- Struck out a career-high six batters in each of his last two starts - June 30th vs.Aberdeen & July 6th vs.Williamsport.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
- The fourth Opening Day starter from the Dominican Republic, joining Jorge Reyes (2006), Pedro P.Martinez (2008), and Yohan Almonte (2010).
- Has tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on two occasions (8/19/10 - DSL Mets vs. DSL Indians & 7/17/11 GCL Mets at GCL Astros).
