**VS. BATAVIA:** The Cyclones come into today's game with an all-time record of 29-9 against the Batavia Muckdogs...The Cyclones went 2-1 against the Muckdogs in 2011.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** Brooklyn is 14-5 in road games with season...The 14 road wins are tied for the most in the NYPL with Tri-City 14...As a team, Brooklyn has pitched to a 1.94 ERA (37 ER/172.0 IP) on the road and a 3.39 (67 ER / 178.0 IP) at MCU Park...The team has scored 82 runs in 19 road roads and 65 runs in 19 home games.

**THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The Cyclones are 20-3 when they score three or more runs, and are 3-12 when they score two runs or less.

**GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD:** The Cyclones are 20-5 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 20 wins are the most in the NYPL... During the entire 2011 season, Brooklyn scored first in 31 games, and won 25 of them.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Yesterday, the Cyclones did not hit into a double play for the first time in seven games...They lead the NYPL with 42 twin-killings ...There are 10 teams in the NYPL who have hit into 26 double plays or less...The Cyclones have hit into 11 double plays in their last seven games...**Phillip Evans** leads the NYPL with eight GIDP.

**EVANS WITHOUT AN E:** After committing four errors through his first 17 games of the season, **Phillip Evans** has not committed an error in his last 19 games...The 19-year-old leads all NYPL shortstops with a .980 fielding percentage and has committed just four errors in 203 total chances.

**SCORING TROUBLES:** The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL in batting with runners in scoring position, batting just .203 (74-365)...Over their last seven games, Brooklyn is hitting just .154 (12-78) with RISP...Over their last eight games, spanning 80.0 innings, the Cyclones have scored just 19 runs and are batting .232 (68-295) as a team.

**HEATING UP:** Cyclones catcher **Kevin Plawecki** is batting .406 (13-32) over his last eight games...Over this span, the 2012 first round selection has collected three hits in a game on three separate occasions.

**AT HOME ON THE ROAD:** Infielder **Alex Sanchez** is batting .346 (18-52) on the road with seven RBI in 13 games away from MCU Park...At home, he is batting just .171 (7-41) with two RBI in 11 games.

**A JUST DESERT:** Cyclones trainer **Eric Velazquez** has been named a trainer for the Surprise Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League.
