LAST GAME: Three Cyclones pitchers combined on a two-hit shutout as Brooklyn defeated Connecticut 3-0 at MCU Park on Friday night to take the rubber July 13th, the 2011 first round pick has hit safely in 17 game of a three-game set...For the third straight game, of 21 games and is batting .337 (29-86) and leads the the Cyclones scored in the first inning, this time with entire NYPL with 12 extra-base hits over this span...In **Phillip Evans** supplying an RBI double and **Stefan Sabol** connecting on a two-run blast to provide all the offense the Cyclones would need...**Luis Cessa** (3-2) got the win and **John Mincone** pitched a perfect ninth to close out the game for his fourth save.

VS. AUBURN: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with an all-time record of 19-16 against the Auburn Doubledays...In 2011, Brooklyn went 2-1 against the Doubledays in what was their first season as an affiliate of the Washington Nationals.

SHUTOUTS: Last night was the Cyclones fifth shut-out of the season...The five shutout are tied with the State College Spikes for the most in the New York-Penn League...Last season, the Cyclones finished third in the NYPL with seven shutouts.

THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 24-4 when they score three or more runs, and are 3-14 when they score two runs or less.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 23-7 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 23 wins are the most in the NYPL... During the entire 2011 season, Brooklyn scored first in 31 games, and won 25 of them.

RISP: The Cyclones went 3-for-14 with runners in scoring position last night, lowering their season-average to .210 (91-433), which is the lowest in the NYPL... In 45 games this season, there have been 19 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including nine time in their last 17 contests... Over their last two games, the Cyclones are batting .179 (5-28) with runners in scoring position

BRANDON NIMMO: Has hit safely in six straight games and is batting .500 (13-26) over this span... Since 2011 first round pick has hit safely in 17 game of a three-game set...For the third straight game, of 21 games and is batting .337 (29-86) and leads the the Cyclones scored in the first inning, this time with entire NYPL with 12 extra-base hits over this span...In **Phillip Evans** supplying an RBI double and **Stefan Sabol** connecting on a two-run blast to provide all the offense the Cyclones would need...**Luis Cessa** (3-2) got the win and **John Mincone** pitched a perfect ninth to close out the game for his fourth save.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .978 fielding percentage...In 1,729 total chances, they have committed a league-low 38 errors...No other team in the NYPL has less than 52 errors.

EVANS WITHOUT AN E: After committing four errors through his first 17 games of the season, **Phillip Evans** has not committed an error in his last 25 games...The 19-year-old leads all NYPL shortstops with a .982 fielding percentage and has committed just four errors in 220 total chances.

RISP: The Cyclones went 3-for-14 with runners in scoring position last night, lowering their season-average to .212 (89-419), which is the lowest in the NYPL... In 44 games this season, there have been 19 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including nine time in their last 16 contests.

PHIELIN' IT: Cyclones shortstop **Phillip Evans** is batting .471 (8-17) over his last four games...He has scored five runs over this span and collected five RBI.

MINCONE THE MAGNIFICENT: Cyclones reliever **John Mincone** extended his scoreless inning streak to 18.1 innings last night...The lefthander has not allowed a run since June 22nd and has a 0.42 ERA (one earned run/21.2 innings).

STEP'ING IT UP: Cyclones outfielder **Stefan Sabol** has hit safely in each of his last five games and is batting .318 (7-22) with two doubles, a home run and four RBI over the span.
