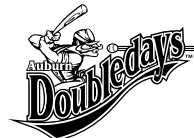

**LAST GAME:** Brooklyn defeated the Auburn Dou-  
bledays 4-1 on Saturday evening to take the first game straight games and is batting .500 (15-30) over this  
of a three-game set...**Hansel Robles** (3-1) allowed span...Since July 13th, the 2011 first round pick has hit  
just three hits and one unearned run over 7.0 innings safely in 18 of 22 games and is batting .344 (31-90) and

**VS. AUBURN:** The Cyclones come into tonight's  
game with an all-time record of 20-16 against the Aub-  
urn Doubledays...In 2011, Brooklyn went 2-1 against  
the Doubledays in what was their first season as an  
affiliate of the Washington Nationals.

**JOHAN SANTANA:** Will take the mound for  
the Cyclones in what will be his first start of his ma-  
jor league rehabilitation assignment...The two-time Cy  
Young Award winner is expected to pitch 3.0 innings or  
40 pitches...Coincidentally, Santana pitched for the Aub-  
urn Doubledays in 1997 and 1998 when they were the  
minor league affiliate of the Houston Astros...He is one  
of three active players who pitched in the NYPL and  
won a Cy Young Award (CC Sabathia, Chris Carpenter).

**REHAB:** Santana will become the 16th New York  
Mets player to play for the Cyclones as part of a re-  
habilitation assignment...Of these 16 players, he will be  
only the fifth pitcher, and the first since **Oliver Perez**  
in 2009...For a full list see page 74 in the media guide.

**THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The  
Cyclones are 25-4 when they score three or more runs,  
and are 3-14 when they score two runs or less.

**GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD:** The Cyclones are  
24-7 on the season when they score the first run of  
the ballgame...The 24 wins are the most in the NYPL...  
In 2011, Brooklyn scored first in 31 games, and won  
25 of them.

**BRANDON NIMMO:** Has hit safely in seven  
games this season, there have been 19 times that the  
Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game,  
including nine times in their last 18 contests.

**THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS:** The Cyclones  
come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .978  
fielding percentage...In 1,766 total chances, they have  
committed a league-low 39 errors...No other team in  
the NYPL has less than 52 errors.

**EVANS WITHOUT AN E:** After committing  
four errors through his first 17 games of the season,  
**Phillip Evans** has not committed an error in his last  
26 games...The 19-year-old leads all NYPL shortstops  
with a .982 fielding percentage and has committed just  
four errors in 224 total chances.

**PHEELIN' IT:** Cyclones shortstop **Phillip Evans**  
is batting .474 (9-19) over his last five games...He has  
scored six runs over this span and collected five RBI.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** The Cyclones have  
scored at least one run in the first inning of each of  
their last four games...For the season, the Cyclones  
have outscored their opponents 22-9 in the first frame.

**K IT AIN'T SO:** The Cyclones pitching staff leads  
the NYPL with 409 strikeouts in 420.0 innings this  
season...**Luis Mateo** leads the league with 58 strike-  
outs, **Rainy Lara** ranks second with 54 and **Hansel**  
**Robles** is fourth with 44 K's.

## BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #57 JOHAN SANTANA (6-7, 3.98 w/ Mets)

- Placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 21st with a sprained right ankle which he initially sustained in his start on July 6th vs. Chicago-NL.
- Became the first pitcher in New York Mets history to throw a no-hitter on June 1st vs. St. Louis...It was the 8,020th game in franchise history.
- Pitched in the New York-Penn League in 1997 and 1998 as a member of the Auburn Doubledays when they were a minor league affiliate of the Houston Astros.
- Has a career ERA of 3.13 (701 ER / 2016.1 IP), the lowest among active qualifying pitchers.
- Is one of only five pitchers to be a two-time unanimous American League Cy Young Award winner (2004 & 2006).
- His 139 career victories rank second in major league history by a Venezuelan-born player (Freddie Garcia-149).
