LAST GAME: The Cyclones completed a three-game sweep of the Auburn Doubledays with a 3-1 win into tonight's game, the Cyclones have posted a mark at MCU Park on Monday afternoon...**Rainy Lara** (6- of 14-3 against teams with winning records this season, 1) got the win after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing one run while going 16-15 against teams that are below .500 on five hits...**Kevin Plawecki** and **Stefan Sabot** hit back-to-back home runs in the fourth inning to provide all the offense that the Cyclones would need.

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with an all-time record of 34-21 against the Lowell Spinners...Brooklyn went 5-1 against the Spinners in 2011, including 3-0 in at LeLacheur Park.

THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 27-4 when they score three or more runs, and are 3-14 when they score two runs or less.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 25-7 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 25 wins are the most in the NYPL... In 2011, Brooklyn scored first in 31 games, and won 25 of them.

THE PLAW: **Kevin Plawecki** is batting .353 (6-17) with three runs scored and five RBI over his last five games...The Cyclones catcher has driven in seven runs in his last six games...The 2012 first round supplemental selection is the most difficult player to strikeout in the NYPL with one K every 18.63 plate appearances.

RISP: The Cyclones went 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position yesterday, and are now batting .213 (99-465), which is the lowest in the NYPL...In 48 games this season, there have been 20 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 10 times in their last 20 contests.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .977 fielding percentage...In 1,836 total chances, they have committed a league-low 42 errors...No other team in the NYPL has less than 53 errors.

WINNING AGAINST WINNERS: Coming out of the month is the same as July, where Brooklyn finished the month 16-13.

PITCHING IN: Over their last four games, in which Brooklyn is 4-0, the Cyclones pitching staff has combined to allow just two runs and 17 hits with four walks and 32 strikeouts in 36.0 innings of work.

PHIELIN' IT: Cyclones shortstop **Phillip Evans** is batting .385 (10-26) over his last seven games...He has scored six runs over this span and collected six RBI.

HOT START IN AUGUST: Brooklyn is off to a hot start this month with a record of 5-1 and have outscored opponents 24-15...The 5-1 record to start the month is the same as July, where Brooklyn finished the month 16-13.

INJURY UPDATE: Cyclones infielder **Dimas Ponce** left Monday's game after being hit on the forearm by a David Fischer fastball...Ponce went for x-rays after the game, which were negative, and the infielder is considered day-to-day...Outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** was hit on the left shoulder by a pitch on Sunday evening...He was not in the lineup on Monday and is also considered day-to-day.

K IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL with 424 strikeouts in 437.0 innings this season...**Luis Mateo** leads the league with 58 strikeouts, **Rainy Lara** ranks second with 57 and **Hansel Robles** is tied for fifth with 44 K's...The team also ranks first in the NYPL with a league-low 342 hits allowed.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones rank second in the NYPL with 26 home runs with season...Brooklyn has 382 hits all season and 118 of them have gone for extra-bases.

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #29 GABRIEL YNOA (3-1, 2.81 ERA)

- Has allowed just one run on five hits over the first two innings in any of his starts.
- Right handed hitters are batting just .162 (16-99) against Ynoa.
- For his career, has walked only 19 batters in 176.1 innings of work.
- In his start on July 19th at Staten Island, allowed a leadoff double and then did not allow another hit for the rest of his outing.
- Struck out a career-high six batters in each of his last two starts - June 30th vs. Aberdeen & July 6th vs. Williamsport.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
- The fourth Opening Day starter from the Dominican Republic, joining Jorge Reyes (2006), Pedro P. Martinez (2008), and Yohan Almonte (2010).
- Has tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on two occasions (8/19/10 - DSL Mets vs. DSL Indians & 7/17/11 GCL Mets at GCL Astros).
