LAST GAME: In what was a classic ballgame at MCU **SHOUTOUT TO SHUTOUTS:** Last night was Park, the Cyclones defeated the Vermont Lake Monster the Brooklyn's New York-Penn League leading eighth 1-0 on Friday evening...**Hansel Robles** made the shutout of the season...For Vermont it was the seventh start for Brooklyn and retired the first 23 batters he time this season that they have been shutout, which also faced before Daniel Robertson broke up his perfect leads the NYPL...The Cyclones have four shutout wins game bid with two outs in the eighth inning...Vermont's in their last eight games...The franchise record for shut-pitchers matched Brooklyn's effort, not allowing a hit outs in a season is 10, set by the 2004, 2006 and 2007 until the ninth inning...**Dimas Ponce** started the ninth Cyclones. inning with a leadoff single, the first Cyclones hit of the game, and came around to score on a **Phillip Evans** **WINNING AGAINST WINNERS:** Coming into tonight's game, the Cyclones have posted a mark of 14-3 against teams with winning records this season, while going 18-17 against teams that are below .500.

VS. VERMONT: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with an all-time record of 37-19 against the Vermont Lake Monsters / Expos...In 2011, the Cyclones went 1-5 against Vermont.

NEAR-PERFECT: Last night's performance by **Hansel Robles** is the second longest in franchise history without allowing a hit...RHP **Miguel Pinango** went 8.2 hitless frames on August 23, 2002 vs. Lowell.

THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 27-4 when they score three or more runs, and are 5-16 when they score two runs or less.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 27-8 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 27 wins are the most in the NYPL.

RISP: The Cyclones went 1-for-4 with runners in scoring position yesterday, and are now batting .211 (102-483), which is the lowest in the NYPL...In 52 games this season, there have been 23 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 13 times in their last 24 contests.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .977 fielding percentage...In 1,983 total chances, they have committed a league-low 45 errors...No other team in the NYPL has less than 55 errors.

QUIET 'CLONES: Over their last four games, the Cyclones have scored only four runs while batting .146 (18-123)...Over their last five games, Brooklyn is batting just .159 (24-151) with seven runs scored...For the season, the Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with a .230 (400-1742) team average and last in runs scored with 192.

DON'T WALK THIS WAY: Coming into this evening's game, the Cyclones pitching staff has issued only one walk in 45.0 innings dating the the eighth inning of the game on August 6th...Brooklyn hurlers have 44 strikeouts and one walk in their last five games.

HOME SWEET HOME: At least two Cyclones are glad to be back at MCU Park as SS **Phillip Evans** is hitting .306 (30-98) at home and .165 (17-103) on the road...C **Kevin Plawecki** is batting .323 (20-62) at home and .173 (13-75) on the road.

K IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL with 459 strikeouts in 471.0 innings this season...**Luis Mateo** leads the league with 67 strikeouts, and **Rainy Lara** ranks second with 57...The team also ranks first in the NYPL with a 2.45 team ERA and has allowed the fewest hits in the NYPL (365)...They have issued just 112 walks, second fewest in the NYPL behind Batavia.
