### BROOKLYN CYCLONES (34-21) at TRI-CITY VALLEYCATS (41-14)

**LAST GAME:** Brooklyn's bats started off sluggish **AT HOME ON THE ROAD:** Brooklyn comes after two-days off for the NYPL All-Star game, going into tonight's game with 17 wins on the road, second 2-for-13 with RISP as the Cyclones fell to Tri-City 6-2... most in the NYPL...**Alex Sanchez** is hitting .321 **Luis Cessa** (3-4) suffered the loss after allowed in two (25-78) on the road and .190 (12-63) at home...Brooklyn runs on six hits in 4.0 IP...**Jayce Boyd** had the lone home run as he has hit 14 of their 16 home runs on the road. RBI for Brooklyn, going 2-for-5 with an RBI groundout.

**WELCOME BACK:** Cyclones OF **Brandon Nimmo** returned to the lineup on Saturday after game with an all-time record of 29-16 against the Tri-City ValleyCats...The Cyclones were 2-4 against the ValleyCats during the 2011 campaign...The two teams also met in the playoffs twice (2004 & 2010) with Tri-City winning both series.

**RISP:** The Cyclones went 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position yesterday, and are now batting .218 (113-519), which is the lowest in the NYPL...In 55 games this season, there have been 23 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 13 times in their last 27 contests.

**THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The Cyclones are 29-4 when they score three or more runs, and are 5-17 when they score two runs or less.

**GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD:** The Cyclones are 28-8 on the season when they score the first run of the ballgame...The 28 wins are the most in the NYPL.

**WINNING AGAINST WINNERS:** Coming into tonight's game, the Cyclones have posted a mark of 14-4 against teams with winning records this season, while going 20-17 against teams that are below .500.

**THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS:** The Cyclones come into tonight's game leading the NYPL with a .978 fielding percentage...In 2,063 total chances, they have committed a league-low 45 errors...No other team in the NYPL has less than 59 errors...**Jayce Boyd**, **Phillip Evans** and **Brandon Nimmo** each lead their respective positions in fielding percentage.

**STRAW THAT STIRS THE DRINK:** This season, the Cyclones are 18-6 when **Brandon Nimmo** scores a run...During the five games that Nimmo was out of the lineup, Brooklyn scored just seven runs and hit .192 (29-151) in the three games since he returned, Brooklyn scored 18 runs and hit .283 (30-106).

**A TALE OF TWO SEASONS:** Through the first 23 games of the season, **Brandon Nimmo** was batting .188 (15-80)...Since July 13th, the Cheyenne, WY native is batting .343 (36-105) with 21 runs scored, and 16 extra-base hits...His 14 doubles over this span leads the NYPL.

**MMBOP:** RHP **Craig Hansen** joined the Cyclones last night and made his first professional appearance since September 6, 2010 with Altoona (AA)...Hansen is currently on a rehab assignment after signing with the Mets on July 24th.

**K IT AIN'T SO:** The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL with 486 strikeouts in 497.0 innings this season...**Luis Mateo** leads the league with 67 strikeouts, and **Rainy Lara** ranks second with 63 and **Hansel Robles** is tied for third with 51 punchouts...The team also ranks first in the NYPL with a 2.55 team ERA and has allowed the fewest hits in the NYPL (398)...They have issued just 120 walks, second fewest in the NYPL behind Batavia.

- Nicknamed "The Little Freak" due to the similarity between his pitching motion and that of San Francisco's Tim Lincecum.
- Has tossed a season-high 3.0 innings on two occasions - July 15th at State College and August 3rd vs. Connecticut.
- Comes into this evening's game having not walked a batter in 14.1 innings dating to his first professional appearance on June 29th vs. Aberdeen.
- Selected in the 13th round pick in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Princeton University.
- Split time as a pitcher and shortstop during his career with the Tigers.
- During his junior season (2012) at Princeton went 4-2 with a 4.66 ERA and three complete games in nine starts...Struck out 58 batters in 56.0 innings on the mound.
