

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #29 GABRIEL YNOA (4-1, 2.45 ERA)

- Has allowed just one run on five hits over the first two innings in any of his starts.
- Right handed hitters are batting just .150 (17-113) against Ynoa.
- For his career, has walked only 19 batters in 183.1 innings of work.
- Tied his career-high with 7.0 IP on August 7th at Lowell...Also established a career-high with eight strikeouts in that same game as well.
- In his start on July 19th at Staten Island, allowed a leadoff double and then did not allow another hit for the rest of his outing.
- Struck out a career-high six batters in each of his last two starts - June 30th vs.Aberdeen & July 6th vs.Williamsport.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
- The fourth Opening Day starter from the Dominican Republic, joining Jorge Reyes (2006), Pedro P.Martinez (2008), and Yohan Almonte (2010)
