LAST GAME: Brooklyn took advantage of three Tri-City errors en route to a 4-1 victory over the ValleyCats on Wednesday night...**Luis Cessa** (4-4) .500 for the 12th straight season...Since 2001, Brooktossed a career-high 7.0 innings, allowing just one run on six hits, walking none and striking out three...**Matt Bowman** pitched 2.0 scoreless frames to close out the win and collect his third save of the season...**Jeff Glenn** had the lone multi-hit effort for the Cyclones, going 2-4 with a run scored and an RBI.

VS. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 2-3 against ValleyCats this season and 30-19 against them all-time.

RISP: The Cyclones are 7-for-34 with runners in scoring position over their last five games... Brooklyn ranks last in the NYPL with a .222 (129-581) average with RISP this season...In 62 games this season, there have been 26 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 16 times in their last 34 contests.

THE KEY IS THREE: The Cyclones are 32-4 when they score three or more runs, and are 6-20 when they score two runs or less.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 31-10 on the season when they score the first run of the game...The 31 wins are tied for most in the NYPL.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Cyclones have hit into seven double plays in their last six games and lead the NYPL with 60 GDP this season...**Phillip Evans** has a grounded into a league-high 10 double plays while **Stefan Sabol** has hit into nine and **Jayce Boyd** as well as **Kevin Plawecki** have hit into seven.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: With 14 games remaining, the Cyclones come into this evening's contest with a 4.0 game lead on Batavia in the race for the NYPL Wild Card...Because of that, any combination of 10 Cyclones wins or Muckdog losses will give Brooklyn their fourth straight playoff appearance.

ALWAYS A WINNER: With last night's win, the Cyclones ensured themselves of a finish of at least .330 (29-88) with 20 runs scored in 21 games.

STRAW THAT STIRS THE DRINK: This season, the Cyclones are 21-6 when scores a run...Since switching to the leadoff spot on July 25th, Nimmo is batting .330 (29-88) with 20 runs scored in 21 games.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS: Through the first 23 games of the season, **Brandon Nimmo** was batting .188 (15-80)...Since July 13th, the Cheyenne, WY native is batting .319 (43-135) with 26 runs scored, and 17 extra-base hits.

PHEELIN IT: Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** has hit safely in five of his last six games and is batting .364 (8-22) over the span.

HOME COOKIN': Cyclones OF **Brandon Nimmo** has reached safely in his last 15 home games... During the streak, which dates to July 9th, Nimmo is hitting .305 (18-59) with seven walks.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL with a 2.53 ERA...They have allowed a league-low 450 hits in 558.0 innings...Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 136 walks and 534 strikeouts.

POWER SURGE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have hit five home runs in their last four games and are ranked second in the NYPL with 36 home runs on the season...Tri-City leads the league with 37 round-trippers...Brooklyn has hit 14 home runs in 20 games during the month of August.

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #29 GABRIEL YNOA (5-1, 2.40)

- Ranks eight in the NYPL with a 2.40 ERA...Is third in WHIP at 0.90.
- Brooklyn is 9-1 this season in games started by Ynoa, and have won each of his last five games.
- Has allowed just one run on seven hits over the first two innings in any of his starts.
- Right handed hitters are batting just .163 (20-123) against Ynoa.
- For his career, has walked only 19 batters in 188.1 innings of work.
- Tied his career-high with 7.0 IP on August 7th at Lowell...Also established a career-high with eight strikeouts in that same game as well.
- In his start on July 19th at Staten Island, allowed a leadoff double and then did not allow another hit for the rest of his outing.
- Participated in the 2012 NYPL All-Star Game on August 14th at Mahoning Valley.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
