### BROOKLYN CYCLONES (38-25) vs. STATEN ISLAND YANKEES (22-40)

**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones lost a tough one on Thursday night, falling to the Tri-City ValleyCats 4-3 in 11 innings...RHP **Beck Wheeler** (1-1) was tagged 20 in ERA in the loss after allowing a two-run home run to NYPL, **Gabriel Ynoa** is eighth, **Luis Cessa** ranks 11th...**Nelfi Zapata** led the offensive charge with a 3-for-5 effort while **Brandon Nimmo** had two-RBI in the loss.

**VS. STATEN ISLAND:** The Cyclones are 5-3 against Staten Island this season, including 3-1 at Staten Island...Brooklyn is 78-70 all-time against their bridge rival

**RISP:** The Cyclones are 10-for-46 with runners in scoring position over their last six games... Brooklyn ranks last in the NYPL with a .223 average with RISP this season...In 63 games this season, there have been 26 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 16 times in their last 35 contests.

**THE KEY IS THREE:** The Cyclones are 32-5 when they score three or more runs, and are 6-20 when they score two runs or less.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** With 13 games remaining, the Cyclones come into this evening's contest with a 3.0 game lead on Batavia in the race for the Wild Card...Because of that, any combination of 10 Cyclones wins or Muckdog losses will give Brooklyn their fourth straight playoff appearance.

**ALWAYS A WINNER:** With Wednesday night's win, the Cyclones ensured themselves of a finish of at least .500 for the 12th straight season...Since 2001, Brooklyn has never finished a season with a losing record...They are one of only five teams in all of professional baseball that can make that claim along with the Boston Red Sox, New York Yankees, Arizona League Giants and Elizabethton Twins.

**STRAW THAT STIRS THE DRINK:** This season, the Cyclones are 21-6 when **Brandon Nimmo**

**A TALE OF TWO SEASONS:** Through the first 23 games of the season, **Brandon Nimmo** was batting .188 (15-80)...Since July 13th, the Cheyenne, WY native is batting .314 (44-140) with 26 runs scored, and 17 extra-base hits.

**ROSTER MOVES:** RHP **Robert Whalen** and RHP **Brandon Welch** were both transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League following last night's game...Both players are expected to be activated in time for tomorrow's game and will make their professional debuts for the K-Mets on Saturday.

**PITCHING IN:** The Cyclones pitching staff leads the NYPL with a 2.55 ERA...They have allowed a league-low 461 hits in 569.0 innings...Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 138 walks and 543 strikeouts.

**NIFTY NELFI:** After going through a 1-for-39 stretch from June 30th - August 1st, **C Nelfi Zapata** is hitting .346 (9-26) over his last seven games...The Cyclones backstop has hit safely in each of his last four games and has scored a run in each contest as well.

**PHEELIN IT:** Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** has hit safely in six of his last seven games and is batting .333 (9-27) over the span.

**BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #29 GABRIEL YNOA (5-1, 2.40)**

- Is 0-4 in his last five starts...Has allowed 16 earned runs on 33 hits over 28.2 innings during this span for a 5.02 ERA.
- Was the starting pitcher for the National League in the NYPL All-Star Game on August 14th.
- Is 3-2 in away games this season with a 1.49 ERA...Has a 1-3 record at MCU Park with an ERA of 5.09.
- Lefties are batting .265 (18-68) against while righties are batting .194 (30-155).
- His 71 strikeouts this season leads the NYPL...Leads the league with a 10.77 k/9 inning ratio... Is fifth in the league having allowing just 60 base runners in 59.1 innings.
- Has struggled with runners in scoring position with the opposition batting .280 (14-50)... With RISP and two outs, the opposition is batting .310 (9-29).
- Last year with DSL Mets 1 (R) went 6-1 with a 2.00 ERA. Struck out 80 opponents and walked only five. His 80 strikeouts were tied for fourth in the Dominican Summer League.
- Resides in Nizao, Dominican Republic and was signed as a minor league free agent in 2011.
