VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones come into this evening's game with an all-time record of 61-43 against Hudson Valley...This year, the Cyclones hold a 6-2 advantage over their division rival.

NEW ADDITION: Gavin Cecchini added to the roster. Cecchini was selected in the first round of the 2012 MLB Draft. This is the second time this season the Cyclones have had three first-round draft picks on their roster; and the third time in franchise history (2008: Ike Davis, Reese Havens, Brad Holt).

RISP: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with a .224 average with runners in scoring position...In 68 games this season, there have been 29 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 19 times in their last 40 contests.

PHEELIN IT: Cyclones SS Phillip Evans has hit safely in nine of his last 12 games and is batting .310 (14-47) over the span...The hot streak has raised Phil's batting average from .229 to .242.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: With eight games remaining, the Cyclones come into this evening's contest with a 2.0 game lead on Batavia in the race for the NYPL Wild Card...The Cyclones hold the head-to-head tie breaker over the Muckdogs having won two-of-three from Batavia earlier in the season. The Muckdogs play Mahoning Valley tonight on the road for a scheduled 7:05 pm game.

ALWAYS A WINNER: The Cyclones have ensured themselves of a finish of at least .500 for the 12th straight season...Since 2001, Brooklyn has never finished a season with a losing record...They are one of five teams in all of baseball that can make that claim along with the Boston Red Sox, New York Yankees, Arizona League Giants and Elizabethton Twins.

SHOUT OUT TO SHUTOUTS: With the 11-0 victory over the Staten Island Yankees on Saturday night, Brooklyn tied their franchise record for shutouts in a season with 10...The Cyclones also had 10 shutouts in 2004, 2006 and 2007...The 10 shutouts this year are the most by a NYPL franchise since 2010 when Auburn had 12 shutouts.

STRAW THAT STIRS THE DRINK: This season, the Cyclones are 22-7 when **Brandon Nimmo** scores a run...Since switching to the leadoff spot on July 25th, Nimmo is batting .308 (34-112) with 22 runs scored in 28 games.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS: Through the first 23 games of the season, **Brandon Nimmo** was batting .188 (15-80)...Since July 13th, the Cheyenne, WY native is batting .305 (47-154) with 28 runs scored, and 20 extra-base hits.

INJURY UPDATES: OF **Eudy Pina** placed on DL with hand/wrist discomfort.

THE KEY IS THREE: The Cyclones are 34-5 when they score three or more runs, and are 7-22 when they score two runs or less.

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #29 GABRIEL YNOA (5-1, 2.30 ERA)

- Ranks ninth in the NYPL with a 2.30 ERA...Is third in WHIP at 0.90.
- Brooklyn is 9-2 this season in games started by Ynoa, and have won five of his last six games.
- Has allowed just one run on seven hits over the first two innings in any of his starts.
- Right handed hitters are batting just .168 (22-131) against Ynoa.
- For his career, has walked only 20 batters in 195 innings of work.
- Tied his career-high with 7.0 IP on August 7th at Lowell...Also established a career-high with eight strikeouts in that same game as well.
- In his start on July 19th at Staten Island, allowed a leadoff double and then did not allow another hit for the rest of his outing.
- Participated in the 2012 NYPL All-Star Game on August 14th at Mahoning Valley.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than J.J. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
