VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 6-5 against the Staten Island Yankees this season and 79 and 72 all-time against their rivals.

SIZZLIN' VS. STATEN ISLAND: Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** is batting .341 (15-44) against the Baby Bombers...In 11 games he has reached base safely 25 times in 54 plate appearances.

NEW ADDITION: INF **Gavin Cecchini** was added to the roster prior to Wednesday's Game...Selected 12th overall, and is the highest drafted player to ever suit up for the Cyclones...This is the second time this season the Cyclones have had three first-round draft picks on their roster, (Nimmo, Plawecki & Hansen) and the third time in franchise history (2008: Ike Davis, Reese Havens & Brad Holt).

RISP: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with a .222 (145-653) average with runners in scoring position...In 70 games this season, there have been 30 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 20 times in their last 42 contests.

WINNING AGAINST WINNERS: The Cyclones are 14-8 against the four NYPL teams with winning records this season and 28-20 against teams that are below .500...The Hudson Valley Renegades have 13 losses in the McNamara Division with seven of them coming at the hands of the Brooklyn Cyclones.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: With six games remaining, the Cyclones come into this evening's contest with a 1.0 game lead over Batavia in the race for the NYPL Wild Card...The Cyclones hold the head-to-head tie breaker over the Muckdogs having won two-of-three from Batavia earlier in the season...Brooklyn needs any combination of five Cyclones wins or Muckdogs losses to clinch a playoff spot.

SAFE AT HOME: OF **Brandon Nimmo** has reached base safely in 18 straight home games dating to July 9th...Over this span Brandon is hitting .286 (20-70) with 12 walks and has a .405 OBP.

ALWAYS A WINNER: The Cyclones have ensured themselves of a finish of at least .500 for the 12th straight season...Since 2001, Brooklyn has never finished a season with a losing record...They are one of five teams in all of baseball that can make that claim along with the Boston Red Sox, New York Yankees, Arizona League Giants and Elizabethton Twins.

THE KEY IS THREE: The Cyclones are 35-5 when they score three or more runs, and are 7-23 when they score two runs or less.

PHILLIP PHANATIC: Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** is batting .331 (42-127) at MCU Park and .171 (25-146) on the road...Phil has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 home games dating to August 2nd and is batting .392 (20-51) in these games.
