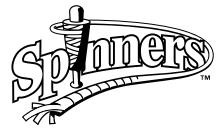
### BROOKLYN CYCLONES (45-29) vs. LOWELL SPINNERS (34-40)

**LAST GAME:** RHP Luis Cessa (5-4) tossed 8.2 innings, allowing just one run on six hits as the Cyclones defeated the Lowell Spinners 4-1 at MCU Park or Batavia loss to clinch a playoff spot...Auburn leads on Monday night...**Kevin Plawecki** led the offensive Batavia by 1.0 game in the race for the Pinckney Div. with a 3-for-4 effort with a run scored and an RBI...**Phillip Evans** added a 2-for-5 performance as well...RHP **Tyler Vanderheiden** recorded the final out of the game with the tying run at the plate for his 12th save.

**VS. LOWELL:** The Cyclones are 2-2 against the Lowell Spinners this season and 36-23 against them all-time...Brooklyn took two of three from the Spinners at MCU Park during the 2011 season.

**NEW ADDITION:** INF **Gavin Cecchini** was added to the roster prior to Wednesday's Game...Selected 12th overall, and is the highest drafted player to ever suit up for the Cyclones...This is the second time this season the Cyclones have had three first-round draft picks on their roster, (Nimmo, Plawecki & Hansen) and the third time in franchise history (2008: Ike Davis, Reese Havens & Brad Holt).

**RISP:** The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with a .224 (152-680) average with runners in scoring position...In 74 games this season, there have been 32 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 22 times in their last 46 contests...Brooklyn has 161 strikeouts with runners in scoring position and 152 hits in these situations.

**WINNING AGAINST WINNERS:** The Cyclones are 14-8 against the four NYPL teams with winning records this season and 31-21 against teams that are below .500...The Hudson Valley Renegades have 13 losses in the McNamara Division with seven of them coming at the hands of the Brooklyn Cyclones.

**PITCHER PERFECT:** Brooklyn has five pitchers in the top 15 in the NYPL in ERA, all below 3.00 - **Robles, Ynoa, Mateo, Cessa, and Lara.**

**PLAYOFF SCENARIOS:** With just two games left in the regular season, the Cyclones need one win to clinch a playoff spot...Auburn leads on Monday night...**Kevin Plawecki** led the offensive Batavia by 1.0 game in the race for the Pinckney Div. with a 3-for-4 effort with a run scored and an RBI...**Phillip Evans** added a 2-for-5 performance as well...RHP **Tyler Vanderheiden** recorded the final out of the game with the tying run at the plate for his 12th save.

**SAFE AT HOME:** OF **Brandon Nimmo** has reached base safely in 21 straight home games dating to July 9th...Over this span Brandon is hitting .272 (22-81) with 13 walks and has a .392 OBP.

**THE KEY IS THREE:** The Cyclones are 38-5 when they score three or more runs, and are 7-24 when they score two runs or less.

**DEFENSE NEVER RESTS:** The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a .977 fielding percentage...In 74 games they have committed just 64 errors.

**PHEELING AT HOME:** Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** is batting .329 (46-140) at MCU Park and .173 (26-150) on the road...Phil has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 home games dating to August 2nd and is batting .375 (24-64) in these games.

**ALWAYS A WINNER:** The Cyclones have ensured themselves of a finish of at least .500 for the 12th straight season...Since 2001, Brooklyn has never finished a season with a losing record...They are one of four teams in all of baseball that can make that claim along with the New York Yankees, Arizona League Giants and Elizabethton Twins.

**RUNNING ON EMPTY:** The Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 31 of their 74 games this season (41.8%)...Brooklyn has scored just 284 runs, third fewest in the league, and is hitting just .231 as a team, third worst in the NYPL.

**END OF REGULAR SEASON**

**BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #29 GABRIEL YNOA (5-1, 2.26 ERA)**

- Ranks eighth in the NYPL with a 2.26 ERA...Is fifth in WHIP at 0.93.
- Brooklyn is 10-2 in games started by Ynoa, and have won six of his last seven starts.
- Has allowed just three runs on 12 hits over the first two innings in any of his starts.
- Right handed hitters are batting just .172 (26-151) against Ynoa.
- For his career, has walked only 22 batters in 200.0 innings of work.
- Tied his career-high with 7.0 IP on August 7th at Lowell...Also established a career-high with eight strikeouts in that same game as well.
- In his start on July 19th at Staten Island, allowed a leadoff double and then did not allow another hit for the rest of his outing.
- Participated in the 2012 NYPL All-Star Game on August 14th at Mahoning Valley.
- Was the youngest Opening Day starter in franchise history...At 19 years, 23 days, he was over a year younger than JJ. Leaper who started the 2007 Cyclones season opener at 20 years, three months and seven days.
