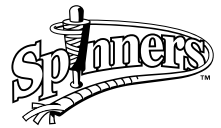

LAST GAME: After waiting out a 57 minute rain delay, the Lowell Spinners defeated the Cyclones 9-1 when they score three or more runs, and are 7-25 on Tuesday night to postpone the Cyclones' hopes of clinching a playoff spot...**Gabriel Ynoa** (5-2) suffered the loss for Brooklyn after allowing two runs, one earned, on four hits over 5.0 innings of work...Two Cyclones relievers allowed seven runs and Brooklyn they have committed just 65 errors. went 1-for-5 with RISP.

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 2-3 against the Lowell Spinners this season and 36-24 against them all-time...Brooklyn took two of three from the Spinners at MCU Park during the 2011 season.

RISP: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with a .223 (153-685) average with runners in scoring position...In 75 games this season, there have been 33 times that the Cyclones have had one hit or less with RISP in a game, including 23 times in their last 47 contests...Brooklyn has 163 strikeouts with runners in scoring position and 153 hits in these situations.

WINNING AGAINST WINNERS: The Cyclones are 14-8 against the four NYPL teams with winning records this season and 31-22 against teams that are below .500...The Hudson Valley Renegades have 13 losses in the McNamara Division with seven of them coming at the hands of the Brooklyn Cyclones.

SINGLED OUT: The Cyclones have not collected an extra-base hit since the 7th inning of the game at Staten Island on September 1st...The streak, which now spans 28 innings, has included 23 straight singles.

PLAYOFF SCENARIOS: With just one game left in the regular season, the Cyclones need one win or Batavia loss to clinch a playoff spot...Auburn has clinched the Pinckney Division and the # 3 seed...Hudson Valley and Tri-City are tied for the best record in the NYPL and the #1 seed in the playoffs...If the Cyclones make the playoffs they will play the winner of the Tri-City vs. Hudson Valley game this evening.

THE KEY IS THREE: The Cyclones are 38-5 when they score three or more runs, and are 7-25 when they score two runs or less.

DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a .977 fielding percentage...In 75 games they have committed just 65 errors.

PHEELING AT HOME: Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** is batting .333 (48-144) at MCU Park and .173 (26-150) on the road...Phil has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 home games dating to August 2nd and is batting .382 (26-68) in these games.

RUNNING ON EMPTY: The Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 32 of their 75 games this season (42.6%)...Brooklyn has scored just 285 runs, third fewest in the league, and is hitting just .231 as a team, tied for second worst in the NYPL.

RECORD BREAKERS: Cyclones SS **Phillip Evans** will tie the franchise record for games played in a single season at 74 if he makes an appearance in tonight's game...He will be the fourth player to appear in 74 games tying **Ian Bladergroen** (2003), **Caleb Stewart** (2005) and **Kirk Nieuwenhuis** (2008)...Evans has already set the franchise record for at-bats in a season...RHP **Hansel Robles** has a 1.11 ERA which will break RHP **Eric Brown's** mark of 1.16 set in 2006.

ALWAYS A WINNER: The Cyclones have ensured themselves of a finish of at least .500 for the 12th straight season...Since 2001, Brooklyn has never finished a season with a losing record...They are one of four teams in all of baseball that can make that claim along with the New York Yankees, Arizona League Giants and Elizabethton Twins.

END OF REGULAR SEASON

BROOKLYN STARTER : RHP #34 LUIS MATEO (4-5, 2.45 ERA)

- Has not won a game since July 14th...Is 0-4 in his last seven starts...Has allowed 18 earned runs on 42 hits over 40.2 innings during this span for a 3.98 ERA.
- Has received less run support through 12 starts than any other Cyclones pitcher (36 runs).
- Was the starting pitcher for the National League in the NYPL All-Star Game on August 14th.
- Is 3-2 in away games this season with a 1.49 ERA...Has a 1-3 record at MCU Park with an ERA of 4.20.
- Lefties are batting .263 (20-76) against while righties are batting .189 (37-196).
- His 85 strikeouts this season leads the NYPL...Leads the league with a 10.43 k/9 inning ratio... Is fourth in the league having allowed just 72 base runners in 73.1 innings.
- Has struggled with runners in scoring position with the opposition batting .250 (15-60)... With RISP and two outs, the opposition is batting .275 (14-51).
- Last year with DSL Mets I (R) went 6-1 with a 2.00 ERA. Struck out 80 opponents and walked only five. His 80 strikeouts were tied for fourth in the Dominican Summer League.
- Resides in Nizao, Dominican Republic and was signed as a minor league free agent in 2011.
